The end of the school year is exciting, but the carefree sunny days of summer do have a downside: the loss of two months of academic progress also known as the “summer slide.”


Did you know?

- Summer reading loss is cumulative. By the end of 5th grade, children who consistently lose reading skills over the summer will be two years behind their classmates.
- More than half of the achievement gap between lower and higher-income youth can be explained by unequal access to summer learning opportunities.
- Studies show that summer learning – and reading in particular – can prevent the “summer slide.”

SUMMER SLIDE ADDS UP

When kids don't read over the summer they fall behind.

By the end of 5th Grade, kids in need are nearly 3 grades behind their peers in reading skills.
